CJHS 8th grade classes have started a recycling program to benefit their class trips as well as helping make a difference in the environment. The program is called M.A.D. going green (Making A Difference). They have begun collecting paper products such as copy paper, newspapers, card board boxes, and alumi-



num cans. AAA Recycling of Greenville, TX will be providing the delivery and pickup of the disposed items as well as providing the trailers for storage. The students are donating the can tabs to benefit a cancer charity and in the near future they will also start collecting ink cartridges and cell phones. The cartridges and cells phones will be sent to CURE recycling to benefit childhood cancer, where they will send the school a small portion of the funds in return. The 8th graders have researched this need for the environment and the gross waste in paper usage and have discovered that every year people throw away enough white paper to build a wall that could measure 4 meters high and could stretch from coast to coast -that is a lot of trees that have been destroyed needlessly!
