Computer Code of Conduct

- Lab computers are available on a first come, first served basis. Computer sessions are one hour long. If no one is waiting for a computer, you may continue use until a request is made.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO** food, gum, candy or drinks are allowed in the media center
- You must sign in/out at the circulation desk to use a computer
- NetBook Laptops are available for checkout at the circulation desk
- Users may not disrupt or disturb other computer users. This includes, but is not limited to: talking loudly with other patrons, cell phone calls, loud music, or displaying text or graphics that may be reasonably construed as offensive
- The Celeste Community Learning Center complies with CIPA (Children's Internet Protection Act) by having a filtering system on its Internet access
- Any attempt to access inappropriate, obscene or sexually explicit material will not be tolerated
- Users may not disrupt or interfere with network services. This includes, but is not limited to: attempts to add, modify or remove system software or other system elements
- Users may not connect their personally owned computing machinery or software to the media center network
- Users may not use the Internet for illegal activity
- Users may not use the computers to falsely represent himself or herself or the media center or use the system for financial or commercial gain
